AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present petition is filed seeking extension of interim bail already granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.3.2023 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal in FIR No. 158 dated 4.10.2020, under Section 22-C and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the Act'), registered at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal on the ground that the wife of the petitioner has to undergo surgery.

Vide order dated 16.03.2023, the petitioner was granted three days interim bail by Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal and now he has surrendered back.

Reply filed on behalf of the State is taken on record, copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State does not dispute the factum of

surgery of the wife of the petitioner on 24.3.2023.

For the reasons mentioned in the petition, the same is allowed.

The petitioner is granted three weeks interim bail on furnishing of bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petitioner will surrender back to the jail authorities immediately after completion of three weeks.
