The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case registered against them vide FIR No.226 dated 05.08.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 452 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Tauru, District Nuh.

Status report by way of affidavit dated 29/30.06.2023 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tauru, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Vide order dated 21.03.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 21.03.2023, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daya Kishan, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.03.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
