The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct an impartial inquiry on the complaint dated 25.12.2022 (Annexure P-9) followed by legal notice dated 12.01.2023 (Annexure P-8).

The grievance of the petitioner is that in spite of the said representation and legal notice, no action has been taken by the respondents with regard to registration of FIR.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

Mr. A.M. Punchhi, P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4-U.T. Chandigarh.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to take a final decision on the representation dated 25.12.2022 (Annexure P-9) and legal notice dated 12.01.2023 (Annexure P-8), within a period of two weeks from today.

The present petition stands disposed of.
