1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking grant of anticipatory bail in the above-captioned case.
2. Upon notice and after hearing learned counsel for the State, the petitioners were directed to join investigation and were granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 08.05.2023.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, P.S. City Rewari, District Rewari, submits that pursuant to order dated 08.05.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation on 24.05.2023 and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the above facts but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 08.05.2023, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
