VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent No.3 to allow the petitioner to submit his 3rd years Prof examination form and allow the petitioner to take the examination thereafter.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has submitted that fee is due from the present petitioner.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Respondent No.3 would be at liberty to initiate proceedings in accordance with law in case any amount is due against the present petitioner.

6. In case any such proceeding is initiated, it would be open to all the parties including the present petitioner and respondent No.3 to raise all pleas as are available to them in accordance with law.

7. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the above.
