The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.04 dated 02.03.2023 under Sections 419, 429, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station NRI, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 29.03.2023 and 20.07.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 29.03.2023 and 20.07.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petitioners have joined the investigation and the original documents i.e. sale deed stands recovered and

has been handed over to the investigating officer.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 29.03.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
