MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents, who are allegedly trying to recover the vehicle of the petitioner with the help of recovery agents and henchmen.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, submits that the parties were called, wherein the respondents made a statement that they were not creating any hindrance in the plying of the truck of the petitioner, much less trying to forcibly seize the vehicle of the petitioner.

In view of the submissions made by the learned State counsel, this Court is not inclined to issue directions, as prayed for, and

the petition stands dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail of any other alternate remedy, as may be available to him under the provisions of law.
