While assailing the correctness of the transfer order dated 16.03.2023 the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari.

On a Court question, the learned counsel representing the petitioner admits that the petitioner has stayed in District Gurdaspur, which is her home District for a period of 7 years out of her total service period of 11 years.

Transfer of an employee is the incidence of service. The State can transfer an employee to a place where he is required.

Hence, no ground to issue the writ, as prayed for, is made out.

Dismissed.
