1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant-wife challenging judgment and decree dated 06.01.2022, passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Bathinda whereby petition under Section 13 (1) (ia) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'), filed by the respondent-husband was allowed. Appellant-Gagandeep Kaur was proceeded *ex parte*.

2. Parties, duly identified by their counsel are present in Court.

3. It is informed that during pendency of this appeal, matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. It was agreed that a sum of Rs.90,000/- shall be handed over to the appellant-wife as full and final settlement of all her claims qua the respondent-husband, including permanent alimony, maintenance etc. Sum of Rs.45,000/- was handed over by the respondent to the appellant on 02.12.2022.

Today balance sum of Rs.45,000/- has been handed over to the appellant, who is present in Court.

4. Respondent, present in Court submits that photographs of their marriage and any other photographs as well as educational certificates of the appellant as available with the respondent shall be handed over to her counsel i.e. Mr. Ravinder Garg at District Courts, Talwandi Sabo, Bathinda within next two days as has been requested by the appellant.

5. Parties submit that none of them shall use each others photographs for any purpose whatsoever in future and not initiate any litigation qua each other. No litigation between them is stated to be pending it is however stated that in case any is found to be pending, same shall be withdrawn by the respective parties. Statements of the parties have been recorded separately.

6. Appellant states that in view of the settlement arrived at she may be permitted to withdraw this appeal.

7. Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.

8. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
