The petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents No. 1 to 3 to refund the balance tax of Rs.17,93,311/- for the AY 2019-20 alongwith upto date statutory interest of AY 2018-19 and 2019-20.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that on account of glitches in the system, payment of refund could not be made in time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even though the petitioner has got refund, the Department is bound to make payment of interest after a period of three months.

This petition is being disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to make a representation for seeking payment of interest. Thereafter, the respondents will consider the representation and will pass an appropriate order and also explain as to why glitches in the system cannot

be made basis for grant of interest.
