SURESHWAR THAKUR, J.(ORAL)

1. Since the challenge made in the instant petition, is to Annexure P-1, as became purportedly passed by the Gram Panchayat, Wazirabad. Further-more, since the resolution (Supra), has been alleged to be forged, as the purported signatures thereons, of the Panches concerned, are allegedly fictitious. Therefore, until the above fact is investigated into, and, or thereafter a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. is instituted, before the jurisdictionally competent Court concerned, thereupto at this stage, this Court does not have any jurisdiction to grant the relief, as asked for in the instant petition.

2. In other words unless the factum of forgery is established but only after the appropriate legal recourse becomes adopted, thereupto at this stage, this Court cannot firmly conclude, that as a matter of fact, the resolution concerned, was prima facie a purportedly forged resolution.

3. In view of the above, this Court at this stage, finds no merit in the instant writ petition, and, disposed of as such. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioners to canvass all appropriate remedies before the authorities concerned. Nonetheless, in case the petitioners do not choose to press any other remedy, they may not do so.
