1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.112 dated 17.08.2016 registered under Section 341, 506, 323, 148 & 149 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala (Annexure P-1).

2. On 28.04.2022, notice of motion was issued and the petitioners as well as respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 23.05.2022 for recording their statement regarding the genuineness of the compromise executed between the parties. The case was listed again on 08.08.2022 and on that very day, learned counsel for the petitioners informed the Court that petitioner No.3-Lovepreet Singh could not appear before the learned trial Court in compliance of the order passed by this Court on 28.04.2022 and a request for extension of time was made for recording his statement and vide order dated 08.08.2022, liberty was granted to petitioner No.3 to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate on 08.09.2022.

3. A perusal of order dated 12.01.2023 indicates that none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

4. Today also, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

5. The report received from the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Patiala indicates that petitioner No.3 has not appeared before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court in compliance of the order passed by this Court on 28.04.2022 and 08.08.2022.

6. In view of the above, it appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the present petition.

7. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
