The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to typographical mistake, the date of representation Annexure P-6 has been wrongly mentioned as 07.04.2022 instead of 13.03.2023. On the oral request, made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the date of representation is ordered to be corrected as 13.03.2023 instead of 07.04.2022 and the registry is directed to carry out the necessary correction.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 13.03.2023, Annexure-P6 to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jind, District Jind and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 13.03.2023, Annexure P6.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Jind, District Jind is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
