AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed for quashing of FIR No. 21, dated 4th February, 2022, under Sections 406, 420, 201 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Phase 1, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) on the basis of compromise.

2. The parties were directed to get their statements recorded *vis-a-vis* the compromise arrived at. As per the report dated 21st September, 2023, received from Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, respondent No.3 and 4 had not come forward for recording of the statements.

3. None has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4. Similar was the position on the last two dates.

4. In view of the above noted fact, the factum of the compromise is doubtful, the petition is dismissed.

5. The petitioner shall be at liberty to file fresh petition in case matter is compromised.

6. Since the main case has been dismissed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
