The appellant seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.148 dated 05.07.2021 registered under Sections 323, 365, 506 and 34 of the IPC, 1860 and Sections 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.03.2023, the appellant has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 17.07.2023 by way of an affidavit of Rashpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police Sub Division, Bhucho, District Bathinda has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the appellant is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 22.03.2023 is made absolute. However, the appellant shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
