Application for permission to withdrawal of the present writ  
petition has been filed by the Union of India.

In pursuance of the last order dated 06.07.2023, costs of ₹1 lakh  
has been deposited with the Society for the Care of Blind (Regd.), Sector 26,  
Chandigarh by way of cheque 21.07.2023. Photocopy of the receipt alongwith  
copy of the cheque has been placed on record. The said order reads as under:-

“The present application has been filed for withdrawal of the  
writ petition by the Union of India on the ground that none of the  
khasra numbers of the suit property now falls within the notified  
area.

Perusal of the paper-book would go on to show that action had been sought against respondent No.6 for the construction that had raised and detailed interim orders have been passed consuming precious judicial time. In such circumstances, we are of the considered opinion that if the writ petition is now to be withdrawn on the basis of the present application, it would only be done by firstly depositing a sum of Rs.1 lakh as costs for consuming the said judicial time. Accordingly, proof of the costs to be deposited with the Institute for Blind, Sector 26, Chandigarh, be filed.

To come up on 31.07.2023 for compliance.”

Keeping in view the above, the application for withdrawal of the writ petition for the reasons given in the application duly supported by affidavit is allowed.

CM stands disposed of.

In view of the above, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
