The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to give her the benefit of promotion and consequential benefits from the date her juniors have been promoted retrospectively vide order dated 10.01.2022 (Annexure P-16). The petitioner has also sought quashing of the final gradation list and the tentative seniority list of Clerks.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his legal notice dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-19) addressed to respondents No.2 and 3, ventilating her grievance, whereupon no decision has been taken as yet, is decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Appearance has also

been caused by Mr. Padamkant Dwivedi, Advocate, on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5.

Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be furnished to the respective counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-19) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
