The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0143 dated 07.11.2022 under Sections 458, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla (Punjab).

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 23.03.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 23.03.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 23.03.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
