1. A perusal of Annexure P-2 appended with the petition discloses, that the marriage of the son of the present petitioner one Navjot Singh, is scheduled on 03.04.2023 at Barnala, and, that the marriage ceremony shall last uptill 04.04.2023. Therefore, the petitioner makes a prayer before this Court that he be permitted to, under police escort attend the marriage of his son, which is scheduled on the above stated dates.

2. The prayer is not opposed by the learned State counsel, as he submits, on instructions from SI Ram Niwas, that the above facts have been verified.

3. Consequently, the instant petition is allowed. The Superintendent of District Jail Sirsa, is directed to ensure the deploying of armed police escort along with the petitioner, to enable him to attend the marriage scheduled on the dates (supra). The release of the petitioner from jail by the Superintendent of District Jail Sirsa, Haryana shall occur in the morning of 01.04.2023, and, shall

last uptill the evening of 07.04.2023. In the evening of 07.04.2023, the police escort shall ensure, that the present petitioner is retrieved into the prison concerned. All the expenses towards the transportation of the petitioner as well as the of armed escorts deployed along with him, besides all the expenses appertaining to the board and lodging of the armed escorts, shall be borne by the petitioner.
