The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release family pension with all consequential benefits alongwith interest @ 12 % per annum. He submitted that the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 has been given to the concerned authorities vide Annexure P-4, but the same has not been considered or decided as yet.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, learned AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab and status that she has no objection in case the legal notice Annexure P-4 issued by the petitioner is considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court deems it fit and proper to dispose of the present petition without calling for reply from the

respondents since the prayer is made only for deciding of the legal notice. Therefore, without observing anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.1/competent authority is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-4) strictly in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from today.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
