1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.123 dated 15.10.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 307, 34 of IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).
2. On 20.07.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor has placed on record a copy of interim order dated 03.07.2023 passed by the trial Court and has submitted that the petitioner, who was released on interim bail by this Court vide order dated 02.06.2022, has been declared proclaimed offender.

There is no representation on behalf of petitioner. In the interest of justice, adjourned to 27.07.2023.
