1. The present application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to recall the order dated 06.01.2023 passed by this Court .

2. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the application is allowed and the main case is restored to its original position.

1. On the oral request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the main case is taken on Board today itself.

2. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas available to him, before the Trial Court at an appropriate stage.

- 3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.
- 4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that both the petitioners belonged to Amritsar and have been falsely involved by the respondent by filing a complaint at Gurugram. He further submits that the petitioners may be exempted from personal appearance before the Trial Court.
- 5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
- 6. In case, any application for exemption from personal appearance is moved by the petitioners before the Trial Court, the Trial Court shall consider the same sympathetically, in view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case.
