Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents not to replace the petitioner with another such temporary employee till regular incumbent is appointed. A direction has been sought to the respondents to release his salary for the months of January and February, 2023.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Perusal of the averments made in the writ petition show that show cause notices have been issued to the petitioner, who is working as a Tubewell Operator with Gram Panchayat-respondent No.7, for unsatisfactory services. Petitioner has responded by submitting a reply. Till now, respondent No.7 has not taken any action. Writ petition is based on a mere apprehension and cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to move a representation, in case, he has not been paid salary due to him.
