1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the disciplinary proceedings, which have been initiated against him and are pending, are causing prejudice to him as the benefits for which he is entitled, have been withheld, hence, the respondents be directed to conclude the said proceedings in a time bound manner so that no further prejudice is suffered by him, especially when the enquiry report has already been submitted since long.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from Vimal Kumar, Assistant submits that the disciplinary proceedings, which are pending, will be concluded within a period of six months i.e. by 30.06.2024 in case, the petitioner cooperates.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will cooperate qua all the proceedings, which are pending against the petitioner and will not ask unnecessary adjournments so as to delay in conclusion of the proceedings in a time bound manner.

4. Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to conclude the disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner by 30.06.2024 with a clear direction to the petitioner to co-operate with the authorities so as to get the proceedings concluded within the time frame granted.
