The claim petition in this case was filed by Amar Kaur and her son Surjit Singh. The learned tribunal awarded a compensation of Rs.50,000/-. Both the claimants aggrieved by the award of the learned MACT, preferred an appeal, which was registered as FAO No.5608 of 2002.

Mr. Arun Sanghi, Advocate, who filed this appeal, did not put in appearance on a few occasions and it was, ultimately, noticed by the Lok Adalat in its order dated 04.01.2012 that both the appellants are reported to have died.

Counsel for the appellants has again not put in appearance. Legal Representatives of the deceased appellants do not seem to have taken any step to come on record.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served by keeping this appeal pending. The record of this appeal is, therefore, ordered to be consigned to record. Liberty is, however, granted to the legal representatives to get the appeal revived by moving an appropriate application, if need be.
