1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily wages service for the purpose of revised pension and pensionary benefits.
2. Mr. Jagbir Malik, Advocate for respondent submits that the relief claimed by the petitioner for counting of daily wages service rendered by him towards qualifying service after being regular in service for the purpose of revised pension and other pensionary benefits has been addressed. He states that a cheque bearing No.727505 dated 26.09.2023 for an amount of Rs.1,05,631/- stands released in favour of the petitioner.
3. In view of the above statement made by Mr. Malik, this petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. However, today no one is present on behalf of the petitioner.

5. This petition is ordered to be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
6. In case, any claim made in the instant petition is still left, the petitioner will be at liberty to make a representation to the Competent Authority, which shall be decided within a period of two months' thereafter by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
7. Ordered accordingly.
