ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (Oral)

1. The correctness of an interlocutory order dated 24.01.2023, passed by the trial court, is assailed by the plaintiff, in this revision petition. The plaintiff's application for summoning the record from the office of the Deputy Commissioner, to confront the witness, has been dismissed by the trial court. The dispute is with regard to the general power of attorney, executed outside the country, which was embossed on 20.07.2016, in the office of the Deputy Commissioner. The plaintiff, while leading his evidence, has already examined PW4, an official from the office of the Deputy Commissioner, who has produced and exhibited on record the power of attorney dated 07.07.2016, as Ex.PW4/A alongwith all its documents. He also wants to summon an official from the Regional Passport Office to confront the witness examined by the defendant. It is an admitted fact that the plaintiff has already led his evidence.

The defence witness is sought to be confronted with documents, which are already the part of the record. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

2. Dismissed.

3. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
