Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.103 dated 13.08.2015, registered for offences under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala, District Patiala, Annexure P-1.
2. Upon instructions received from SI, Pavittar Singh, State counsel submits that on conclusion of investigation, final report has been presented before the learned Judicial Magistrate on 10.08.2023 and notice has been issued to the complainant for next month.
