Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned award dated 12.08.1998 (Annexure P-1) passed by Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panitpat, whereby his claim for reinstatement with full back wages was rejected.

Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner had joined as shoe man in Haryana Harijan Kalyan Nigam at shoe production centre Karnal in 1982, but his services were dispensed with w.e.f. August, 1993 by the Nigam without giving him any notice. He has contended that the claim of the workman seeking full backwages has been wrongly and illegally decided against the petitioner-workman by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panipat, therefore, through this writ petition the petitioner-workman is seeking indulgence of this Court by invoking extra ordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned

counsel that the services of the petitioner were allegedly terminated in August, 1993 and the industrial dispute raised by him was decided through impugned award dated 12.08.1998 and the writ petition has been filed after a long delay of approximately 25 years.

In view of above, this Court does not find any ground to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction, as the claim raised by the petitioner-workman suffers from delay and latches.

Dismissed.
