Petitioner No.1 – Grrjent Singh, aged about 21 years 8 months, who is stated to be already married and petitioner No.2 – Mansi Devi, aged about 20 years 4 months, have approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to official respondents to protect their lives and liberty, as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of private respondents, who do not approve of their live-in relationship.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, whereas Mr. Rahul Soi, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 & 5 and filed his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

Without commenting as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a

direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 21.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law. In case, it is found that there is a genuine threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

At this stage, both the learned counsel have assured that they shall arrange a meeting between the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 & 5. This Court certainly has no objection for the same.

A copy of this order along with copy of the representation dated 21.03.2023 be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

It is, however, clarified that the aforesaid order shall not confer any immunity upon the petitioners, in case it is found that they have committed any wrong.
