1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of complaint case No. 50 dated 10.03.2012, under Sections 18-(a)(1), 27(b) (i), 27 (c) and 27(d) of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 filed by the Drug Control Officer, Ambala City (Annexure P-1), pending before the Ld. JMIC, Ambala, as also the summoning order dated 10.03.2012, whereby the petitioner has been summoned to face trial under Sections of 18 (a)(1), 27(b)(i), 27(c) and 27(d) of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.

2. It is fairly submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that during the pendency of the instant *lis* all the complainant witnesses have been examined and now the trial is fixed for defence evidence/arguments .

3. In view of the above submissions, as made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is ordered to be rendered infructuous leaving liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas before the learned trial Court at the time of final arguments.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
