1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.117 dated 19.07.2022 registered under Sections 302, 324 and 34 of IPC, at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.
2. Custody certificate has been filed by the learned State counsel today in the Court, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. The same is taken on record.
3. It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the allegations against the petitioner are totally false, frivolous, concocted and fabricated. The petitioner is not involved in the crime at all as alleged against him. The petitioner is in custody since 19.07.2022. The investigation of the case is already over. The petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes. Hence, the petitioner deserves to be released on bail pending trial.
4. On the other hand, learned State Counsel, being instructed by ASI Jatinder Pal Singh, submits that the petitioner is one of the main accused, who had caught hold of the deceased alongwith another person when the third accused slit

the throat of the deceased. Not only that an eyewitness to the incident made a specific statement to this effect.

5. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere so as to grant bail to the petitioner pending trial, at this stage.

6. Dismissed.
