By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass and humiliate the petitioner and his family members on account of repeated complaints made by the private respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulbir Singh, P. S. Valtoha, District Tarn Taran, submits that so far, neither the petitioner nor any of his family members are required by the investigating agency in any of the criminal proceedings. He further submits that in case, the petitioner or any of his family members are required at a later stage, they shall be served upon with notice under Section 41A Cr.P.C.

In view of the aforesaid statement, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press this petition at this stage.
