The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.15 dated 27.02.2019 registered under Sections 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Phul, District Bathinda as well as order dated 13.09.2021 along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the complaint case, the petitioner has paid the whole amount to the complainant-Bank and thereafter the complaint case has been withdrawn by the respondent-bank vide order dated 17.01.2023 passed by the trial Court. In view of the fact that the complaint case has been withdrawn by the complainant-Bank, continuance of the proceedings under Section 82 of the Cr.P.C. would not be in the interest of justice.
