1. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submitted that in the present case the prayer is for grant of benefit of counting of past service and regarding which a legal notice dated 16.02.2023 (Annexure P-15) was given to the respondents and the writ petition has been filed on 21.03.2023 just after one month. It is submitted that the writ petition has been filed at an early stage and reasonable time has not been granted to the respondents and therefore he may be granted liberty to withdraw the present petition in order to enable him to file fresh petition after some period of time in case any cause of action survives.

2. Prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

3. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage

4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition at an appropriate stage and in case so required in accordance with law.
