ALOK JAIN, J. :

The instant petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 09.02.2023 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar, vide which the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in FIR No. 29 dated 01.08.2020, under Sections 498-A/354 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Court of competent jurisdiction. However, he prays that since the petitioner was granted the concession of anticipatory bail by the trial Court vide order dated 18.09.2020, confirmed on 28.09.2020, let the learned Court below decide his bail application, expeditiously.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Court below within a period of seven

days from today and in case, the petitioner applies for regular bail, the said bail application be decided on its own merits, within two days thereafter, after serving notice upon the State.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
