Petitioners have approached this Court with a prayer that as per the policy dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-8) of the respondents, petitioners intend to exchange the land with that of HSVP leading to an arrangement, which would be beneficial to not only the petitioners but HSVP as well. He has highlighted that as of now the land which is owned by the petitioners as well as the land adjacent to the land of the petitioners, which is owned by HSVP, is irregular in shape. The policy permits such exchange of land in a manner where the land can be adjusted in such a manner that the same becomes regular. Relying on this policy dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-8), petitioners have submitted a representation dated 01.02.2023 (Annexure P-9) to the Chief Administrator, Haryana Shahari Vikas Pradhikaran, Panchkula, but the same has not been considered nor any decision taken thereon.

Counsel contends that the petitioners at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Chief Administrator, HSVP, to consider and take a decision on the representation dated 01.02.2023 (Annexure P-9) within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition by directing the Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 01.02.2023 (Annexure P-9) submitted by the petitioners within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith.
