The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of order dated 05.09.2022 passed by the trial Court in case FIR No.232 dated 15.06.2021 registered under Sections 120-B, 302 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (to which Section 201 of the IPC was added later on) at Police Station Ambala Cantt, District Ambala whereby the bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled, his bail bonds were forfeited and warrant of arrest was issued against him.

At this stage, Mr. Munish Behl, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his memo of appearance which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner has already filed application for grant of anticipatory bail which was dismissed by the trial Court vide order dated 04.03.2023.

After arguing at length for some time and faced with likely consequences, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to appear before the trial Court and to file an application for grant of bail which may be decided by the trial Court expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within 10 days from today and on doing so he may file an appropriate application for grant of bail and if any such application filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the trial Court expeditiously.
