This petition in the nature of certiorari is filed for quashing of order dated 6.6.2018 (Annexure P-5) rejecting the prayer for grant of licences and also order dated 9.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) dismissing the appeal against the rejection order.

Brief facts of the case are that the father of the petitioner was possessing licence of double barrel gun. After his death, the petitioner applied for licence in his favour. The licence was rejected mainly on the ground that petitioner has not furnished the affidavits of other LRs along with the application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now the LRs have given the affidavits in favour of the petitioner. He submits that a fresh application would be made attaching the affidavits concerned.

Learned counsel for the State is not in a position to raise any serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the authority concerned with fresh application.

There is no doubt that in eventuality of the petitioner making an application, the same shall be decided in accordance with law without being influenced by the impugned order.

Petition is disposed of.
