MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.58 dated 20.04.2022 for the offences under Sections 323, 341, 336, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 17.04.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation.

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR in question and it was only in supplementary statement made on 20.04.2022, the petitioner was nominated as an accused in the FIR in question; the role attributed to the petitioner

along with co-accused was of hurling brick bats and firing couple of shots in the air, with their respective fire arms.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 17.04.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 17.04.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
