Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing of impugned transfer order dated 21.03.2023, Annexure P-3, whereby petitioner has been transferred from Kaithal to Ambala.

Heard counsel for the petitioner.

Transfer is an exigency of service. An employee does not have a right to insist on a station of posting of his choice or permanently stay at one place. Considering that the petitioner is 55% disabled, he has been transferred to an adjoining town, which is barely 80 kms from Kaithal on the national highway. There are no allegations of *mala fide* against any authority.

This Court does not find any reason to interfere with the impugned transfer order.

Petition is dismissed.
