1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction for quashing the order dated 22.12.2022 passed by respondent No.2 in which respondent No.2 has failed to address the issue of the local residents' inability to access the main road due to illegal encroachment by a private individual on an area clearly marked as "22 ft. street" by respondent Nos.4 and 5.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since there are disputed questions of facts arising in the present case thus, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to institute appropriate proceedings including civil suit for the grievances of the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
