This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.395 dated 02.10.2021 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 34 IPC, 1860, (Section 201 IPC 1860 added later on) registered at Police Station Division 5, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner in the Court and the same is taken on record.
