The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 17.11.2020, passed by this Court in CWP-9005-2020, vide which, it was directed that respondent No. 6 shall not be permitted to discharge the duties of the post of Secretary of District Red Cross Society, Narnaul.

As per affidavit filed by the General Secretary, Indian Red Cross Society, Haryana State Branch, Chandigarh, which is on record, it is stated that compliance of the order has been made, vide office order dated 18.11.2020 and one Balwan Singh was directed to discharge the duties of the post of Secretary, District Red Cross Society, Narnaul additionally.

As per affidavit of respondent No. 2/Assistant Secretary, District Red Cross Society, Narnaul (respondent No. 6 in the aforesaid writ petition), filed today in Court, it is specifically stated that aforesaid Balwan Singh is performing the duties of the post of Secretary, District Red Cross

Society, Narnaul and he has no concern with the function of the said post.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.
