On 06.07.2023, learned counsel for respondents No.3 & 4 sought time on the ground that the matter was at advanced stage of settlement between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. On 18.10.2023, the following order was passed:-

- In compliance of the aforementioned order, the statement of respondent No.3-Satya Parkash Gupta was recorded as follows:-

“That I have arrived at settlement with Jaagrati Sharma on 11.09.2023 in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Hon’ble Court and I have no grievance left with above referred Jaagrati Sharma. The settlement has been arrived at with our free will and consent without any fear or coercion and I have no objection if the petition is allowed and the Kalendra against Jaagrati Sharma in FIR No.381 dated 30.05.2015, Police Station Civil Line, Karnal under Section 506 IPC is quashed.”

The petitioner has already withdrawn CRM-A-1660-2019 on 30.10.2023 on the basis of the compromise dated 11.09.2023. Similarly, FIR No.426 dated 05.11.2020 under Section 228-A of IPC registered at Police Station Karnal, Civil Lines, District Karnal was quashed on the basis of compromise in CRM-M-45816-2022 on 05.10.2023. In view of the settlement arrived between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 06.11.2023, the present petition is allowed and the *kalandra* dated 04.01.2017 under Sections 182/211 of IPC (Annexure P-5) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed *qua* petitioner.
