The instant petition has been filed under section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case DDR No.24 dated 06.05.2021 under Sections 307, 336, 188, 269, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act and Section 51-B of Disaster Management Act in FIR No.29 dated 02.05.2021, registered under Sections 307, 336, 188, 269, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act and Section 51 B of Disaster Management Act, at Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.03.2023 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 29.03.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
