Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.4 and 5 to release the amount of Rs.11,86,673/- alongwith interest @ 18% per annum on the basis of final bill submitted by the petitioner.

A short affidavit of Dr. Amandeep Kaur, ADC, Urban Development, Amritsar has also been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2, wherein it has been mentioned that no relief has been sought against the said respondents.

On the other hand, learned counsel for respondents No.3 to 5 contends that the present petition has become infructuous since the entire due amount has already been released in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petition does not dispute the above factual aspect.
