Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Amit Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kanina, District Mahendergarh on behalf of respondent-State has been filed.

It is stated by learned State counsel that the petitioner has since joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 24.03.2023.

On 24.03.2023, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0237, dated 12.07.2022, registered at Police Station Sadar Kanina, District Mahendergarh, under Sections 323, 341, 506/34 of IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on).

As per FIR, petitioners Jai Parkash Sharma and Ravinder and one unknown person (later on identified as Parmeshwar) had waylaid complainant on 06.07.2022 and gave injuries to him with iron rod and kick blows.

It is contended by learned counsel that though the alleged occurrence took place on 06.07.2022, but the FIR was registered on 12.07.2022. Notice under Section 41 Cr.P.C. was issued to the petitioners on 03.03.2023, i.e. after a period of 9 months. It is further submitted that all the offences are bailable except Section 506 IPC. Even the

alleged injury attracting Section 325 IPC is on the non-vital part of the body.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 04.05.2023 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioners are directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. They will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on interim bail on their furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Considering the fact that petitioner has since joined the investigation, the order dated 24.03.2023 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
