1. On the instructions from Sh. Sandeep Singh, Law Officer, the learned counsel representing the appellant (State of Punjab) submits that both the Courts have set aside the order passed on 25.01.1989 while stopping two increments of the respondent with cumulative effect.
2. While admitting the appeal, the appellant was not granted any interim protection and during the pendency of the appeal, the benefits as per the judgments of the Courts below were released.
3. The learned counsel representing the State of Punjab submits that the respondent on attaining the age of superannuation would have retired and he has also expired.
5. Hence, he does not wish to press the appeal.
6. Dismissed as not pressed.
