Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.,
praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.
151 dated 29.10.2022 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian
Penal Code at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 27.03.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the
order dated 06.07.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has handed over a
Demand Draft No.563770 dated 24.07.2023 amounting Rs. 99123/- in the
name of co-accused Rajpal Singh to Mr. H.S. Deol, Advocate, appearing for

him in the Court. Mr. H.S. Deol, Advocate, undertakes to hand-over the same to Rajpal Singh and to clear the dues towards the complainant.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.03.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
